



Specialty vehicle appraisal (SVA) region (Collision Only)

Aside from the geographical regions, the Specialty Vehicle Appraisal (SVA) region exists to ensure program participants that repair a high volume of SVA vehicle types, are measured against other participants with a similar vehicle work mix.

To qualify for the SVA region, a participant's ICBC work mix volume must include at least 50% of the vehicles outlined below:

Chevrolet	Corvette	2014-Present
Jaguar	All models	All years
Land Rover	All models	All years
Mercedes-Benz	All models	All years

ICBC will annually review all Collision repair program participants vehicle work mix to determine eligibility for the SVA region. If a participant believes their facility may be eligible for the SVA region due to a change in work mix between tiering dates, they should speak with their MD Account Services representative.
