Hello Everyone,

Last year, we announced our second multi-year rate framework for Collision Repair Program Participants with a labour rate increase of approximately 6% over three years. Effective July 1, 2026, Participants will receive a 2% labour rate increase as part of year two of the framework.

This increase, along with the paint and body materials shared earlier this year is part of a continued effort to ensure industry sustainability.

The new labour rates and new billable allowances for Commercial Collision Repair Independent & Dealership will apply to:

- all repairs in progress on July 1, 2026, with a vehicle-in date of April 1, 2026, or later and
- new estimates written July 1, 2026, or later

The new labour rates are as follows:
