Hello Everyone,

Last year, we announced our second multi-year rate framework for Commercial Collision Repair Program Participants with a labour rate increase of approximately 6% over three years.

Effective July 1, 2026, Participants will receive a 2% labour rate increase as part of year two of the framework. This increase is on top of [paint and body material and increases](#) and [introduction of new billable items](#) shared earlier this year, are part of a continued effort to ensure industry sustainability.

The new Commercial Collision Program labour rates are as follows and apply to:

- all repairs in progress on July 1, 2026 with a vehicle-in date of April 1, 2026, or later
- new estimates written July 1, 2026, or later.

Mechanical	\$139.93	\$142.73
Frame	\$139.93	\$142.73
Feather, Prime & Block (one-stage)	\$133.22	\$136.14
Feather, Prime & Block (two-stage)	\$142.58	\$145.81

The increase is designed to help address rising cost pressures faced by industry, while delivering on our commitment to keeping rates affordable for British Columbians.
