# What's Changing and Why?



## Why?

- At current consumption rate we will run out of driver's licence numbers in 2023



## What's Changing?

- New driver's licence numbers will increase to eight digits
- The new number series will start with a "3"





## What's Not Changing?

- Existing driver's licence numbers will be unchanged at seven digits
- B.C. Identification (BCID) Numbers

### Current State

 <b>Client Number</b>	<b>01234567C</b> 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9

### Future State

 <b>Driver's Licence Number</b>	<b>Renewal</b> (no change) <b>1234567</b> 1 2 3 4 5 6 7	<b>New Driver</b> <b>30000001</b> 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8
 <b>Client Number</b>	(no change) <b>01234567C</b> 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	(no change) <b>30000001C</b> 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9

# Readiness for the change



## Steps you need to take to get ready

1

### Conduct Impact Assessment

- System to system interfaces
- Data storage and use
- Forms & prescribed forms
- Reporting
- Public facing info
- Searches and views for driver's licence numbers

2

### Make Changes

- Make changes to your systems, forms or processes

3

### Testing

- Conduct integrated testing with ICBC

4

### Confirm Readiness

- Your system should be able to support a seven or eight digit number by August 2023

Partners assess impacts & confirm support required.

**October** - start partner **integration testing**

2023

**June** – Partner system changes complete

**July** - Partner **integration testing** finalized

**August - Go Live!**  
**Ready to accept eight digit number**

Partners prepare systems/forms/processes for changes launching August 2023

## Driver licence number (DLN) changes

ICBC is expected to run out of driver's licence numbers (DLNs) in 2023 based on current consumption rates. To ensure service continuity when this occurs, ICBC will be increasing the length of DLNs from 7 digits to 8.

We expect this change to occur by the fall of 2023. Driver's licences issued before this will not be changed or affected. BCID numbers will not change.
