Hello Everyone,

Last year, we announced our second multi-year rate framework for Collision Repair Program Participants with a labour rate increase of approximately 6% over three years. Effective July 1, 2026. Participants will receive a 2% labour rate increase for year two of the framework.

This increase, along with the [paint and body material increases](#) and [introduction of new billable items](#) shared earlier this year, are part of a continued effort to ensure industry sustainability.

The new Collision Repair Program rates are as follows and apply to:

- all repairs in progress on July 1, 2026 with a vehicle-in date of April 1, 2026, or later
- new estimates written July 1, 2026 or later.
