| The following rates may apply to any vehicle repairs with a car-in-date on or after March 31, 2025, when the Participant satisfies the customer's transportation needs as outlined in the ICBC Material Damage Claims Procedures and the Collision Repair Program Guide. Participants may receive the new ATS Hourly Rate when the estimate profile is updated for vehicle repairs in progress with a car-in date of January 1, 2025, or later. The ATS Hourly Rate may be applied by the Participant when a replacement vehicle is not provided up to May 1, 2025, then the flat \$100 Allowance rate must be used. | | |

The following hourly rates are in addition to the Program Rates on eligible vehicle repairs with a car-in-date on or after August 18, 2025 (Exotic) and May 19th, 2026 (Classic). Eligibility is outlined in the ICBC Material Damage Claims Procedures. Participants must utilize the default Mitchell labour entry lines, then apply a rate differential as a “My Template” line for each separate labour type.

Exotic & Classic Vehicle Repair Rate Schedule

| Rate Type | Rate Differential | Total including materials |
|--|--------------------------|----------------------------------|
| Body | \$29.53/hour | \$126.12 |
| Structural Aluminum (rate adjusted to match exotic & classic Body rate) | \$11.64/hour | \$126.12 |
| Frame | \$33.74/hour | \$143.14 |
| Mechanical | \$37.96/hour | \$160.14 |
